

The Department of Communication, Liberal Arts, Social Sciences (CLASS) at the New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology (New Mexico Tech) invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor of Communication, beginning August 2010. The successful candidate will: be a specialist in composition, writing and communication; work with other writing faculty and with the Department Chair to advance the Writing Program; contribute to a well-established Bachelor of Science program in Technical Communication. Duties will include contributing to the Writing Center and teaching three courses per semester—a combination of College English (expository writing and research writing) and technical writing, upper division writing, graduate writing and communication, Technical Communication courses, or in an area related to candidate's research. Primary responsibility will be to implement communications-related aspects of graduate curriculum in support of New Mexico Tech's Promoting Post baccalaureate Opportunities for Hispanic Americans (PPOHA) program. Ph.D. in Communication, Technical Communication, Writing, Composition Studies, Rhetoric and Composition, or closely related field, record of scholarly potential and of teaching excellence are required. ESL experience or certification and knowledge of assessment are preferred. This position is funded through a Title V PPOHA grant.
